

Pana Community Hospital Announces Operational Changes

Pana Community Hospital, Community Medical Clinic, Pana Medical Group, and LiveWell Fitness announce the following operational changes in order to protect our patients, staff, members, and community. This protocol may change AT ANY TIME.

- All elective services have been suspended.
- Community Medical Clinic and Pana Medical Group (including all outlining clinics) will continue operations subject to screening. Evening hours are temporarily suspended.
- All patients of the Rehabilitation services and Cardiopulmonary Phase II attending scheduled appointments will be screened and may be required to self-quarantine from the program or activity for 14 days.
- Cardiopulmonary Phase III sessions will be suspended until May 1st.
- LiveWell Fitness will be closed to members until May 1st including group classes and individual use of all equipment.
- The Harvest Café at Pana Community Hospital will be CLOSED to the public through May 1st.
- All public meetings sponsored by or held at Pana Community Hospital will be suspended until June 1st.
- Transport services will be suspended until further notice.
- A modified visitor policy is in effect and posted at our hospital. Please refer to our website to read the policy in detail.
- All persons seeking to enter the hospital will be screened outside the main and emergency entrances. All other entrances are closed to the public.

Pana Community Hospital's number one priority during these unprecedented times is to keep our team members, patients, and communities safe. We ask that you assist us with our efforts by staying home and leaving only when it is absolutely necessary or in the case of emergency.

If you have a fever, cough, sore throat, or shortness of breath, please call your primary care provider for instructions before coming to the hospital or clinic.
