Pana Community Hospital, Community Medical Clinic, Pana Medical Group, and LiveWell Fitness announce the following operational changes in order to protect our patients, staff, members, and community during this pandemic.

These operational changes may be revised AT ANY TIME.

- Our surgery department is now open. Patients are required to have a COVID-19 test prior to procedure. Surgery will contact patient with further instructions.
- Community Medical Clinic and Pana Medical Group (including all outlying clinics) will continue operations subject to screening.
 - Video visits are strongly encouraged
 - Video or telephone visits are mandatory for all patients with respiratory symptoms
 - In-person office visits for patients with non-respiratory symptoms will be at the discretion of the providers
 - Testing for all respiratory illness for patients of Community Medical Clinic of Pana and Pana Medical Group will be performed as a drive up service on the hospital campus near the MABAS tent.
- All patients of the Rehabilitation services and Cardiopulmonary Phase II attending scheduled appointments will be screened and may be required to self-quarantine from the program or activity for 14 days.
- LiveWell Fitness is open with guidelines in place. (Please visit facebook.com/livewellpch for further information).
- Transport services are available on a limited basis.
- One visitor per patient is permitted to enter the facility. The visitor will be required to wear a mask and will be screened.
- All persons seeking to enter the hospital will be screened outside the emergency entrance until June 15. On June 15th the front entrance will be open. All patients and visitors will be screened at both entrances and will be required to wear a mask. All other entrances will closed to the public until further notice.
- The following are suspended until further notice:
 - Cardiopulmonary Phase III sessions
 - All public meetings sponsored by or held at Pana Community Hospital
 - The Harvest Café at Pana Community Hospital is closed to the public.

If you have a fever, cough, sore throat, or shortness of breath, please call your primary care provider for instructions before coming to the hospital or clinic.

If you do not have a primary care provider and are experiencing the above symptoms, call the Christian County Health Department at 824-4113 or the Illinois Department of Public Health COVID-19 hotline at 1-800-889-3931.
